Dear parents/carers,

We have been extremely impressed with the resilience and determination exhibited by students in recent weeks. As you will be aware, examinations are not going ahead for students who are completing GCSE, A-level and technical/vocational qualifications this summer, owing to the pandemic. Instead, the school will recommend to exam boards the grades students should be awarded, based on students' performance in assessments set by the school.

In order to support the collection of the evidence required for this process, students in Year 11 and Year 13, and Year 12 students studying Level 2 Health and Social Care, will follow a different timetable in week commencing Monday 24th May (the final week before the half term break).

Please find below the timetable for Year 11, Year 13 and Year 12 Level 2 for w/c Monday 24th May.

For this week, students in Year 11, Year 13 and Year 12 Level 2 will not follow their normal timetables. Instead, they will only attend sessions when there is a need for a range of evidence to be collected to support the awarding of their grades. Subject teachers will make students aware of when they are required to attend sessions. Owing to the wide range of subjects studied by students in Year 11, individual students in this year group will receive a timetable setting out which sessions they should attend. Students in these groups will not be required to attend school after Friday 28th May.

Students should arrive at school at 8.45am for P1+2 sessions and at 10.45am for P3+4 sessions. During this time, students will not attend registration and will instead be registered by teachers in the sessions they attend. Students attending the full morning session will spend break time in either the View (Y11) or the Café area (Y12/Y13). Students will be able to purchase food in The View at break time and lunchtime; students entitled to free school meals will continue to receive their entitlement during this time.

Students attending sessions during this week must adhere to normal uniform and dress code at all times. Further details regarding leavers' trips, leavers' assemblies and the returning of school equipment and emptying of lockers will be shared with students via their tutors.
