As we move into the last three weeks of the academic year, please find below some updates about the work of the school.

End of the summer term

The end of the summer term will be on Friday 16th July 2021. School will finish on this day at 12.40pm, at the end of period 4, and students will be asked to leave the building by 1pm. Students entitled to free school meals will be provided with lunch on this day by the school.

Collection of exam results

Students in Year 13 will collect exam results on Tuesday 10th August. Students in Year 11, and Level 2 students doing resit GCSEs, will collect results on Thursday 12th August.

Appeals following exam results

Details about the appeals process, for any students who are not happy with their grades, will be sent directly to students and parents in advance of students receiving their results in August.

Summer School

At Mulberry UTC, Summer School will take place in w/c Monday 16th August. The Summer School provision will focus on supporting students to close any gaps in learning that have opened up as a result of the pandemic.
